



HUMIDITYTAG HYGROMETER



Operating Instructions

INSTRUMENT OPERATION - Press the ON/OFF button to switch on. Press the ON/OFF button to power to switch between Humidity and Temperature. To switch off, press and hold the ON/OFF button for three seconds. There is no auto power-off feature.

MAX/MIN - Press MAX/MIN to swap between the two readings. To clear the reading whilst in MAX/MIN mode, hold down the button for three seconds to reset all readings. '---' will be displayed.

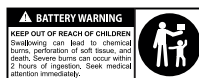
Please note: reading will only clear for the selected Temperature or Humidity and not both. The MAX/MIN reading will be show on screen for 12 seconds if no button is pressed.

°C/°F - To switch from °C to °F, double press the ON/OFF button. When powered off this will power up in the last set scale/s. Factory setting is Centigrade.

BATTERY REPLACEMENT - The battery is located at the rear of the instrument. Remove the battery cover with a coin and turn in the direction of the arrow. Replace battery with a CR2032 lithium coin cell battery before re-tightening the battery cover.
